

Activities for Kids in Bayfield



- Take a swim at the Bayfield Recreation Center & Swimming Pool.
- Play on the public beach at the end of Broad Street or visit the warm, shallow beach 7 miles south of Bayfield on Hwy. 13 at Bay View Beach.
- Visit the huge city playground, at the end of 1st Street & bring a picnic lunch.
- Shopping in mind? Try Apostle Island Outfitters & General Store, Inspire, Brownstone Centre, Sweet Sailing, Keeper of the Light, Bayfield Books, The Yulery, and of course, the Candy Shoppe for kids' items.
- Visit the Apostle Islands Nat'l Lakeshore Hdqrs. and learn how to become a junior ranger.
- Take sailing lessons from North Coast Community Sailing.
- Get a tasty ice cream cone at the Candy Shoppe, Hurricane Hut, or the Pier.
- Hike along the Brownstone Trail, climb the Ravine Trail or walk across old Iron Bridge.
- Go kayaking with one of Bayfield's adventure outfitters.
- Rent bikes at Bayfield Bike Route and see the town!
- Take a historical walking tour...maybe the Ghost Tour?
- Collect rocks on the beach...try skipping stones.
- Pack a picnic and take it to Memorial Park or to Myer's or Little Sand Bay beaches.
- Visit the wonderful children's section at the Bayfield Carnegie Library.
- Take a ferry ride to Madeline Island and discover the island life.
- Visit the Bayfield Fish Hatchery and learn about breeding & growing fish.
- Take a walk along the city dock and count how many boats you find.
- Fish off the Bayfield fishing pier at the end of 1st Street next to the playground.
- Take a fishing charter or a sailing charter or cruise and see the islands.
- Visit the Bayfield Heritage Museum & Maritime Museum to see how people use to live.
- Go berry picking at the orchards: pick strawberries, blueberries, raspberries or apples.
- Watch fishing tugs come and go and see fishermen unloading their catch.
- Visit an orchard and watch jams and apple cider being made.
